

Advance Passenger Information System or APIS is passport and associated information which the governments of various countries, including Algeria, require airlines to collect from passengers prior to travel.

We will only provide each country's Customs and Immigration Authorities with the relevant information required by them; however some governments require airlines to provide them with direct access to airline passenger bookings (PNRs) which may contain other passenger data.

It is important you give us this information prior to arrival at the airport to avoid extra time spent queuing at checking-in.

It is also important that the information is accurate so that you do not have any delay when you pass through Immigration on arrival.

What happens to anyone refusing to provide Advance Passenger Information?

Passengers who refuse to supply Advance Passenger Information may not be allowed entry to Algeria and therefore will not be accepted for travel.

Can passengers still provide Advance Passenger Information at the airport?

It is strongly recommended that whenever possible this information be provided before going to the airport as this will reduce airport congestion and the amount of time you need to spend checking-in.
