Occidental Petroleum Corporation (Oxy) is an international oil and gas exploration and production company, as well as a major North American chemical manufacturer. The fourth-largest U.S. oil and gas company, based on equity market capitalization, Oxy has more than 30,000 employees and contractors on four continents. Oxy is an acknowledged leader in applying advanced technology to boost production from mature oil and natural gas fields and access hard-to-reach reserves.

More than one-fourth of Oxy's worldwide oil and gas production comes from the Middle East/North Africa region, where the company has been an active investor for more than four decades. Oxy is the second-largest oil producer in both Oman and offshore Qatar, and a participant in the giant Dolphin Project, the premier transborder natural gas project in the Middle East. One of region's largest energy initiatives, Dolphin supplies natural gas – produced from wells offshore Qatar, processed at Ras Laffan and transported through a 230-mile-long subsea export pipeline – to markets in the United Arab Emirates and Oman. Oxy also has oil and gas operations in Abu Dhabi, Bahrain, Libya and Yemen.

In the United States, Oxy is the leading oil producer in Texas and New Mexico, and the No. 1 natural gas producer in California, where it recently made the state's largest oil and natural gas discovery in 35 years. Latin America operations include producing assets in Colombia, Argentina and Bolivia.
